- 1. Playground Updates: Buddy Benches: Have been installed. Will talk to the kids on April 25 assembly about how they work.
  - Tetherballs: District is slowly removing them because they are difficult to maintain. Ms. Wilsdon will consult with the staff to see if there is interest in keeping them.
  - The Rocks will be installed on the sledding hill.
- 2. Budget
  - New projector system and screen (much larger). Approx total cost \$6K for projector/screen, \$3K for installation
